

# Carbon Reduction Plan 2026-2027

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## 1. Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Transputec Limited, a West London-based IT solutions provider, is committed to achieving net zero carbon emissions by 2040. Our history of delivering value to clients through technology expertise and innovative solutions has shaped our approach to sustainability. In this report, we outline our baseline carbon footprint, recent initiatives, and future targets.

## 2. Baseline Carbon Emissions Footprint and Current Reporting Period

We have measured our baseline for the reporting year April 2021-March 2022 following improved gathering of information on emissions.

Overall emissions have decreased from 7,635.105 tCO<sub>2</sub>e in the April 2021-March 2022 baseline year to 5,627.005 tCO<sub>2</sub>e in the April 2025-March 2026 reporting year, representing a reduction of 2,008.100 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, or approximately 26.3%. This reduction is mainly driven by lower Scope 3 emissions and is supported by reduced Scope 2 electricity consumption, improved reporting methodology, and changes in working practices.

Scope Changes:

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- Scope 1 emissions increased due to AV units added.
- Scope 2 emissions reduced due to reduction in electricity consumption.
- Scope 3 emissions decreased from 7,603.419 tCO<sub>2</sub>e in the April 2021-March 2022 baseline year to 5,606.532 tCO<sub>2</sub>e in the April 2025-March 2026 reporting year, primarily reflecting lower reported supply chain emissions, supported by improved reporting methodologies and changes in working practices.

### 3. Emissions reduction targets

Our ongoing objectives are to continue to:

- Reduce paper and electricity consumption.
- Recycle waste product - plastic, can, paper, cardboard, glass and food waste
- Engage with waste disposal carriers and vendor's WEEE programs to dispose of IT waste product in as environmentally friendly way possible.
- Procurement of office supplies - purchase product that a) is made of recycled material and/or b) can be recycled (if not soiled) - where possible
- Continue to improve and look at ways to address environmental issues within the business.
- Engage with Customers and Suppliers to jointly look at ways to reduce impact upon the environment.

To achieve a 50% reduction in Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions by 2031, we will need to reduce combined Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions from the 2021-2022 baseline of 31.686 tCO<sub>2</sub>e to approximately 15.843 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2031. Current combined Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions are 20.473 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, representing a reduction of approximately 35.4% against the baseline.

- Transitioning to 80% renewable energy usage by FY2027.

Scope 3 will remain the largest area of emissions and therefore the main focus for future reduction activity. During 2026-2027, Transputec will prioritise improved supplier emissions data, increased use of activity-based reporting, engagement with delivery partners on logistics emissions, and clearer tracking of hardware-related purchased goods and services.

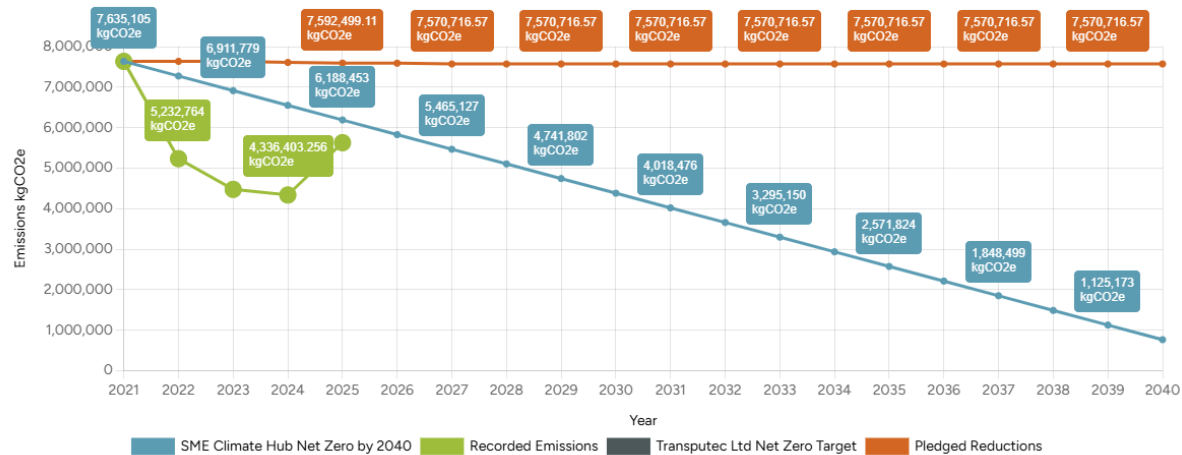
To achieve net zero by 2040, we require a 90% reduction in carbon emissions compared with the 2021-2022 baseline. Based on baseline emissions of 7,635.105 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, this equates to a reduction of approximately 6,871.595 tCO<sub>2</sub>e. Any residual emissions will be addressed through appropriate carbon removal or offsetting in line with recognised net zero guidance. Key actions include:

- Transitioning to 80% renewable energy usage by FY2027.
- Aiming for a 50% reduction in Scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions by FY2031.
- Moved to 'activity-based' reporting

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## 4. Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the April 2021-March 2022 baseline. Over the same period, total reported emissions have reduced by 2,008.100 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, from 7,635.105 tCO<sub>2</sub>e in the baseline year to 5,627.005 tCO<sub>2</sub>e in the April 2025-March 2026 reporting year, representing a 26.3% reduction against the baseline. These initiatives have contributed to this reduction, alongside improved reporting methodologies and changes in working practices.

- Replacement of 98% of fluorescent lighting with LED panels
- Installation of EV points at office
- Replacement of company diesel van with an electric van
- Installation of 70 solar photovoltaic panels on the rooftop in September 2023– resulting in renewable kWh energy for internal use generated from solar since that date.
- Replacement of less energy efficient IT equipment with new equipment to make use of better efficiencies.
- Reduced our waste production and recycling more product.
- Science Based Targets Initiative – registered in September 2023
- Adoption of Rejoose carbon data solutions in 2024 to move towards activity-based reporting.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Moving from a 'spend-based' approach to the calculation of emissions to a 'activity-based' approach to reporting emissions.
- Looking at ways to calculate with our delivery partners the emissions for delivery.
- Looking at further ways to reduce kWh consumption in the office.
- Implementing more robust method of calculating home working emissions.

For 2026-2027, we estimate further emissions reductions of 1,000 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, equivalent to a 17.8% reduction against the current reporting year total of 5,627.005 tCO<sub>2</sub>e.

### Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standards for Carbon Reduction Plans. Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard<sup>1</sup> and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting<sup>2</sup>. Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been

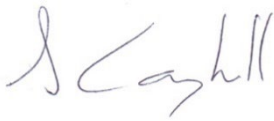
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reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard<sup>3</sup>.
